

THE PASSOVER AND TIME

I. PURPOSE

The Passover was an animal, it is a time and it is our Savior Jesus Christ (Yahshua, Messiah). To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven. God (Elohim) has chosen both this season and time to fulfill his will concerning the salvation of mankind. He has chosen this season of the year to be the beginning of months. II. BACKGROUND TEXTS FOR DISCUSSION

A. The Passover body

1. The LORD'S (Yahweh) first Passover was the body of an animal. Exodus 12:1-11.
2. The animal's body was temporary until the final sacrifice. 1 Cor. 5:1-7; Hebrews 9:11-14.

B. The Passover time

1. God (Elohim) appointed a specific time, the day of Abib 14 to remember his mighty works and deeds. Exodus 12:14; Mark 14:12; Luke 22:7.
2. Abib 14 is the only day that Jesus (Yahshua) is physically present with us. Matt. 26:26-28; 1 Cor. 11:24-30.
