

**THE LAST GREAT DAY OF THE FEAST**

**I. PURPOSE**

Today we conclude both the ends of the Feast of Harvest and the last of the annual Sabbaths. These appointed Sabbaths keep alive the memory of the LORD'S (YAHWEH'S) wonderful works. During these eight days we have heard his word and learned. We have been taught to fear his name and observe all of his laws. We are to rejoice and be thankful to God (Elohim) for his plenteous blessings. He has blessed our store and our increase, and has given us the blessing of salvation, which is his Son Jesus (Yahshua). Our hearts rejoice as we look to the coming harvest when Jesus (Yahshua) shall send his angels to reap the harvest of the earth. This lesson teaches us to keep this feast in memory of the LORD'S (Yahweh's) past works, and in anticipation of the Second Coming of his Son.

Memory Verse: Zec 14:9 And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.

2. It is a day of rest and a holy convocation. Lev. 23:36; John 7:1-38.
